Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Due to the large number of employees potentially leaving the company in August and September through the VSP, Boeing Pension Services will be offering additional retirement training sessions. These sessions are open to VSP participants and will be geared toward the completion of the Pension Commencement Packet. Attending employees should bring their Pension Commencement packet with them, so that specific individual questions can be addressed. Session dates and times are as follows:

<u>DATE</u>	<u>TIME</u>
August 6	3:00 – 5:00
August 11	1:00 – 2:30 and 3:00 – 5:00
August 19	3:00 – 5:00
August 24	1:00 – 2:30 and 3:00 – 5:00
September 1	3:00 – 5:00

All sessions will take place in the building 100 auditorium and employees must attend on their own time.

Finally, if you haven't already done so, we encourage all employees assigned an August or September separation date to request their pension commencement packet as soon as possible. Please request this packet even if you are undecided. Failing to request this packet in a timely manner will result in a reduction of pension benefits. To request your packet, please follow these steps:

1. Call Boeing TotalAccess at (866)-473-2016, enter your BEMS ID, and say "PENSION" when prompted for the reason for your call.
2. You will be asked to key in your TotalAccess Password on your telephone key pad. If you don't know your password, you can still be connected to the Pension Service Center and get your pension commencement packet mailed to your address of record.
3. You will be connected with a representative from the Pension Service Center. Identify yourself as part of the IAM 837 Voluntary Separation Program, and let them know you want to request your pension commencement packet. You will need to let them know your separation date, and your benefit commencement date must be the first of the following month (for example, if your separation date is 9/30/2015, then your benefit commencement date must be 10/1/2015).
4. They will confirm your marital status, your spouse's date of birth, and will talk with you about the forms you need to complete and return (proof of birth, marriage certificate, etc.)
5. Once your pension commencement packet has been requested, you will be assigned a Retirement Life Event Coordinator (RLEC) who is familiar with the VSP, and will be able to help you through the retirement process.
